3	AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF WESTLAKE,
4	FLORIDA; PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 166 OF THE FLORIDA STATUTES;
5	THE CITY COUNCIL HEREBY DECLARES A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN
6	THE CITY OF WESTLAKE GIVEN THE IMPACTS CREATED BY
7	HURRICANE IAN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR
8	CONFLICTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

11	WHEREAS, Hurricane Ian was a major hurricane that severely impacted
12	portions of the State of Florida; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 22-218
15	declaring that a state of emergency exists 24 counties in the State of Florida,
16	including Broward County; and
17 18	WHEREAS, Governor Ron DeSantis issued an amended Executive Order
18 19	Number 22-219, declaring a state of emergency exists in the entire State of
20	Florida; and
21	Piorida, and
22	WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Westlake finds that it is in the
23	best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Westlake to declare a state
24	of emergency.

26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY FOR
27	THE CITY OF WESTLAKE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
28	
29	SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are confirmed, adopted and
30	incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.
31	SECTION 2. In accordance with the authority vested in it by Chapter 166
32	of the Florida Statutes, the City Council declares that in order to protect the life,
33	health, property and public peace and to address the impact of Hurricane Ian has
34	had on the City of Westlake and that a state of emergency exists in the City of
35	Westlake.
36	
37	SECTION 4. Conflicts. All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
38	resolutions or parts of resolutions which are in conflict herewith, are hereby
39	repealed to the extent of such conflict.

41	SECTION 5. Severability. Should the provisions of this ordinance be
12	declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this
13	ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such

1	decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses,
2	and phrases of this ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the
3	legislative intent that this ordinance shall remain notwithstanding the invalidity
4	of any part.

6	SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its
7	passage and adoption by the City Council of the City of Westlake.
