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4 SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are confirmed, adopted and
5 incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.
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7 SECTION 2. In accordance with Section 166.021(4), F.S., and at the request of
8 the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections, the qualifying dates for the City's March
9 2024 general election are hereby established as November 7, 2023, at 12:00 p.m. through
10 November 14, 2023, at 12:00 p.m.

11 SECTION 3. The City Council deems it the best interest of the residents of the
12 City of Westlake to change the date of the regular City election to be held on March of 2024
13 to be held on March 19, 2024 which is the Presidential Preference Primary Election.
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15 SECTION 4. Conflicts. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, resolutions or
16 parts of resolutions which are in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of
17 such conflict.
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19 SECTION 5. Severability. Should the provisions of this ordinance be declared
20 to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall for any
21 reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity
22 of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this ordinance but they shall
23 remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this ordinance shall remain
24 notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.
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
26 SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption on
