CONSTITUTION WEEK

WHEREAS, September 17, 2026, marks the two hundred thirty-ninth anniversary of the drafting and signing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention in Philadelphia in 1787; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States remains the foundation of our nation's government and the protector of the rights and liberties of all Americans; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize this historic document, the anniversary of its creation, and the patriotic observances that commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 84-915 authorizes the President of the United States to annually proclaim September 17 through September 23 as Constitution Week; and

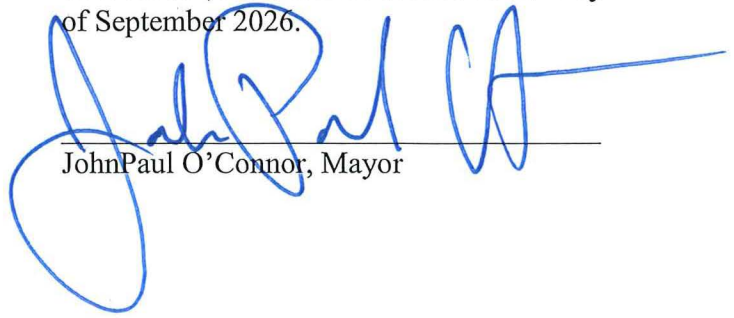
